## MDO DOOR CONSTRUCTION

In order to provide our customers with a better door using medium density overlay (MDO) faces, we have changed our door construction. Due to upgraded manufacturing techniques MDO doors now are provided with a VT 1/16" hardwood edge without exposed crossbanding. This construction provides our customers with a more uniform appearance after finishing.

VT has also changed the MDO material. Unprimed MDO will be brown in color, similar to a paper sack. Primed MDO will have an uneven white wash effect. Most colors of paint will cover with standard painting procedures, some may require an additional coat. This new MDO material will allow the painter to achieve a finish that is far superior over the old MDO material which had inherent characteristics such as orange peel, creases and telegraphing properties that required additional field preparation.
